Legalism: The means by which we seek to earn favor with God and/or validate our standing with God before others through the lowering of God's demands by substituting our imperfect obedience or by creating more accessible rules.

Driving Question:

How Are We Saved Before God?

1. The Legalist Answer: 17 As he was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

a. Through Knowing Him

18 "Why do you call me good?" Jesus asked him. "No one is good except God alone."

b. Through Trusting Him

22 But he was dismayed by this demand, and he went away grieving, because he had many possessions. 23 Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!"

c. Through Following Him

"You lack one thing: Go, sell all you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

d. Through Being Loved by Him

21 Looking at him, Jesus loved him... 27 Looking at them, Jesus said, "With man it is impossible, but not with God, because all things are possible with God."
